

**BICYCLE RACE RELEASE AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT  
AND  
ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF TRANSPORTATION CODE SECTIONS**

I, the undersigned bicycle rider, for and in consideration of participating in the bicycle race described herein below (the "Event"), AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

"I understand that operating, racing and/or riding bicycles on public roadways can be a dangerous practice. I further understand that this bicycle race will be over public streets and roadways, and that Williamson County, Texas, a political subdivision of the State of Texas, has not taken any steps to control the traffic on those routes and that I am SOLELY RESPONSIBLE for my own safety and my own conduct. I understand that at any time, if I feel I am in danger or could be in danger by participating in this Event, I am free to leave immediately and should do so.

**"FOR THAT REASON, AND IN EXCHANGE FOR PARTICIPATING IN THE EVENT, I HEREBY AGREE AND DO RELEASE, DEFEND, INDEMNIFY, AND HOLD HARMLESS WILLIAMSON COUNTY, TEXAS AND ITS OFFICERS, DEPUTIES, AGENTS, OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES, AND I HEREBY AGREE TO SAVE, DEFEND AND INDEMNIFY THEM FROM ANY AND ALL PRESENT OR FUTURE CLAIMS, DEMANDS, OBLIGATIONS, ACTIONS, CAUSES OF ACTION, RIGHTS, DAMAGES, COSTS, LOSSES OF SERVICES, EXPENSES, COMPENSATION AND/OR PUNITIVE DAMAGES WHICH I OR MY HEIRS AND SUCCESSORS NOW HAVE, OR WHICH MAY HEREAFTER ACCRUE OR OTHERWISE BE ACQUIRED, ON ACCOUNT OF, OR IN ANY WAY GROWING OUT OF, OR WHICH ARE THE SUBJECT OF ANY CLAIM OR LOSS INVOLVING (DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY) MY PARTICIPATION IN THE EVENT, INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, ANY AND ALL CLAIMS FOR BODILY AND PERSONAL INJURIES TO ME OR PERSONS IN VEHICLES USED OR OWNED BY ME, WHICH I OR MY HEIRS AND SUCCESSORS, HAVE OR MAY HAVE IN THE FUTURE."**

I further agree and acknowledge that I have read Chapter 551 of the Texas Transportation Code and that I understand the sections set forth therein. Specifically, I acknowledge and understand the following sections of Chapter 551 of the Texas Transportation Code:

§551.103 (c) Persons operating bicycles on a roadway may ride two abreast. Persons riding two abreast on a laned roadway shall ride in a single lane. Persons riding two abreast may not impede the normal and reasonable flow of traffic on the roadway. Persons may not ride more than two abreast unless they are riding on a part of a roadway set aside for the exclusive operation of bicycles.

§551.105 (a) In this section, "bicycle" means a non-motorized vehicle propelled by human power. (b) A sponsoring organization may hold a competitive bicycle race on a public road only with the approval of the appropriate local law enforcement agencies. (c) The local law enforcement agencies and the sponsoring organization may agree on safety regulations governing the movement of bicycles during a competitive race or during training for a competitive race, including the permission for bicycle operators to ride abreast.
