





Potential Cedar Park Projects for Williamson County 2019 Bond Election




#1 Whitestone Blvd widening:
Bagdad Road to Anderson Mill
Road – ‘shovel-ready’ status

#2 Toro Grande extension:
Parmer Lane to Whitestone
Blvd


#3 Brushy Creek Road
widening: Arrowhead Trail to
east of Ranch Trails

Trail: Connect Brushy Creek
Regional Trail to Lakeline Park
with pedestrian bridge over
Bell Blvd

#1 - RM1431/Whitestone Boulevard widening: Bagdad Road to Anderson Mill Road – get to ‘shovel-ready’ for 6 lanes divided




- \$7.3 million: ROW, ENV and PS&E only
- Early ROW acquisition
- Environmental Clearance from 2006
- 2023 completion
- In the WilCo Transportation Plan



#2 - Toro Grande Blvd extension: Whitestone Blvd to Parmer Lane

Construct new 4 lane divided Primary Collector



- \$7.3 million: design and construction
- Preliminary alignment
- 2022 - 2023 completion
- Supports County Plan mobility intent
 - Provide mobility options
 - Addresses bottleneck
 - Improves emergency response



#3 - Brushy Creek Road: Arrowhead Trail to east of Ranch Trails

Widen to 4 lanes divided



- \$5.5 million: Design and Construction – includes a traffic signal at Ranch Trails
- Most ROW acquired, alignment schematic
- 2022 completion
- In the WilCo Transportation Plan

Brushy Creek Regional Trail Connection to Lakeline Park:

With construction of a dedicated shared-use path bridge



- \$2.5 million: design and construction
- Preliminary feasibility study underway
- 2022 completion
- In the WilCo Parks Master Plan
- Supports the request by the County
