COVID-19 AND RELATED CORONAVIRUS


This Second General Order is issued in response to the Local State of Disaster that has been declared by the County Judge of Williamson County, as well as the declarations by the Governor of the State of Texas, and by the President of the United States, and in conformance with *First Emergency Order Regarding the COVID-19 State of Disaster* issued by the Supreme Court of Texas and the Court of Criminal Appeals¹ (Attached hereto), and any further orders.

The CHILD WELFARE COURTS FIND, in compliance with the above directives/orders, good cause under Texas Family Code Section 107.004(e) for court-appointed attorney ad litem to confer with the child or other individual, as appropriate, by telephone or video conference.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that court-appointed attorney ad litem are authorized to confer with the child or other individual, as appropriate, by telephone or video conference until June 1, 2020, subject to being extended by further orders.

This order shall be filed with the Williamson County District Clerk and shall be published on the "All District Courts" webpage.


