



To Attorneys that serve as Attorney-Ad-Litem for Parents and Children in Cases cases filed by the Texas Department of Family and Protective Services:


Effective September 1, 2013, the Texas Family Code requires a minimum of 3 hours of continuing legal education relating to representing children in child protection services case and 3 hours of continuing legal education relating to parent representation in child protection cases. See Section 107.004(b)(c) and 107.0131.

Due to these new requirements, each attorney currently on the CPS appointment list will be given until January 1, 2014 to complete these requirements, if you currently do have meet these requirements. New attorneys applying to be added to the appointment list must meet these new requirements at the time of application.

There are on-line courses available through the State Bar of Texas that are available to you to meet these requirements.


