**Additional Requirements:**

- Dress: Neat, casual attire (sneakers and jeans with no holes are acceptable)  
Cell Phones: **Must be turned OFF while working – NO TEXTING**  
Pay: Student will be paid the clerk's rate of \$10/hr (\$12/hr in Primary)  
Meals: Not provided, please bring your own  
Hours: Approximately 6:30am to 7:30pm  
Training: Must attend one in-person training class held in Round Rock  
Transportation: Must be able to provide own transportation to and from poll site.  
Other: Must be a United States citizen. Enrollment in elections payroll system is required.
