


Project Scope




- ❑ Project will reconstruct CR 259 and portion of CR 266
- ❑ Construct 2-lanes of an ultimate 6-lane roadway along CR 259 from US 183 to CR 266
- ❑ Construct 2-lanes of an ultimate 6-lane section along CR 266 to SH 29
- ❑ Improve drainage along CR 266 within project limits
- ❑ Provide 12-ft lanes and improve intersection with SH 29 and US 183

Project Layout – Along CR 266




Right of Way




- ❑ **Last Time: Conceptual Plans - No right of way was needed along CR 266**
- ❑ **Update: Construction Plans – Will need additional right of way to accommodate improved drainage**
- ❑ **Existing 15-ft roadway widening easement per plat**
- ❑ **Existing fences will need to be removed**
- ❑ **Status: appraisals ongoing, property owner to be contacted**
