

WILLIAMSON COUNTY SIDEWALK MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR POLICY

PURPOSE

The purpose of this Sidewalk Maintenance and Repair Policy is to provide guidelines and regulations relating to Williamson County's maintenance and repair of sidewalks situated in the unincorporated areas of Williamson County, Texas.

POLICY

Williamson County has built various sidewalks during construction of roadway projects. The following is a list of such sidewalks which Williamson County will maintain and repair:

All sidewalks which are not specifically described above and which are located in the unincorporated areas of Williamson County must be maintained and repaired by the owner of the property whereupon the sidewalk is either situated or adjacent to unless the responsibility for maintenance and repair of a particular sidewalk is otherwise the responsibility and obligation of a Homeowners Association, Municipal Utility District or some other entity that the property is subject to.

The Williamson County Commissioners Court reserves the right to add additional sidewalks to the above cited list on a case by case basis in the future.

This Williamson County Sidewalk Maintenance and Repair Policy was considered and approved in a duly called Regular Session of the Commissioners Court of Williamson County, Texas, on the 30th day of July, 2013. This Policy shall be effective as of said date and will remain in force until amended or terminated by the Williamson County Commissioner's Court.
