

WILLIAMSON COUNTY  
CULVERT SETTING POLICY  
REVISED IN COMMISSIONERS COURT -- 4/12/94

- I. A permit from the Williamson County Road & Bridge Department will be required for any culvert or other structure to be placed within County Right of Way. There will be no charge for this permit.
  
- II. Culvert types and sizes must be approved by the County prior to their placement. A representative of the Williamson County Road and Bridge will inspect the site to make determinations on the structure and its placement according to our requirements.
  
- III. The County will not sell or deliver culverts for private or commercial use. All persons needing culverts set must acquire them for themselves and have them delivered to the site where they are to be installed.
  
- IV. The County will set culverts for individuals for a fee of \$5.00 per linear ft. Included in this service the County will provide the labor and equipment needed to set the culvert and enough flexible base material to adequately cover said culvert. The County will not set any culverts for commercial property or real estate development. Commercial property owners must take out a County Permit but must have the installation done by either themselves or a private contractor and in compliance with County standards.
  
- . Any unusual type of structure or inordinate culvert lengths over thirty feet must be approved in writing by the County Road And Bridge Department.
