



Corridor C / SH 29

Greetings,

Thank you for requesting updates on the Corridor C / SH 29 Study. As you know, Williamson County is conducting a study to enhance safety and mobility within the project area by constructing a controlled access road from Sam Houston Avenue at Patriot Way to SH 29 in Precinct 3.

Over the last 18 months, the project team has been working to develop a preliminary recommended route, a schematic, and determine right of way (ROW) needs for future corridor preservation. Two open houses were held to gather input from the community as part of this study. In addition, the project team analyzed environmental constraints, such as floodplains and historic properties, and minimized impacts to homes and businesses.

Next steps for the Corridor C / SH 29 Study include the development of Plans, Specifications, and Estimates (PS&E) documents for Phase 1 of the project and ROW acquisition, which is expected to begin later this year.

At this time, there is no funding for future project development phases.
