ORDER GRANTING OCCUPATIONAL DRIVER LICENSE

The Court grants the above-named Petitioner an Occupational Driver License pursuant to Transportation Code Sec. 521.248, and orders the Petitioner to:

- 1) Restrict driving to travel to and from work or school and essential duties, including medical appointments, court, attorney's office, probation office, and any supervision, education, or counseling required by this Order.
- 2) NOT drive a commercial vehicle.
- 3) Maintain valid auto liability insurance or other financial responsibility in accordance with Chapter 601 of the Texas Transportation Code for the entire period this order is in effect.
- 4) Carry a certified copy of this Order and, after issuance, an Occupational Driver's License while driving. (The Department of Public Safety will mail the Occupational Driver's License within 31 days of the date of this Order after payment of the \$10.00 Occupational Driver's License fee.)
- 5) Restrict driving to no more than ____ hours per day, and only on the days, times, and in the counties or on the routes listed below. *A person may operate a motor vehicle for no more than four hours within a 24 hour period unless the defendant demonstrates an essential need, in which case the court may allow a person to drive up to 12 hours in a 24 hour period.*
